Chapter Membership Eligibility and Dues

Active duty, former and retired Commissioned and Warrant Officers of the US Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, Coast Guard, National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA), Public Health service (USPHS), Guard and Reserves who are members of MOAA are eligible. Widows or widowers of a deceased member, or a deceased individual eligible for membership, are eligible for Auxiliary membership. Auxiliary members are encouraged but not required to be MOAA members.

Regular Membership: Dues are FREE for the remainder of the year in which you join. The dues of \$25 per year or \$100 for five years collected with the application will be applied to the next full calendar year. Dues renewal payments are made in January. Dues are FREE for members age 90 and over as well as for Active Duty members who receive our chapter newsletter by email.

Auxiliary Membership: Dues are FREE for the remainder of the year joining with the \$20 annual or \$75 for five years dues collected with the application applied to the next full calendar year. Dues are also FREE for members age 90 and older.

MOAA Membership: Regular chapter members must also be members of MOAA. If not currently a MOAA member, our application form offers a choice of :

BASIC Member. FREE membership with newsletters and a special version of the Military Officer magazine delivered by email plus MOAA website access to a range of personal and financial services exclusive to MOAA membership.

PREMIUM Member. Full access to everything MOAA offers including one-on-one career counseling, resume reviews, travel and product discounts, exclusive publications and news updates, college scholarships for dependents and more.
One year dues are \$37, 2 years \$72 or 3 years \$95.
